COLLECTING YOUR CHILD FROM SCHOOL

A reminder to parents/carers that the school day ends at 3.20pm and you collect your child from their classroom door. ACADEMY UNIFORM

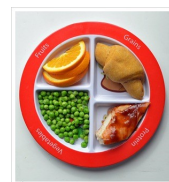

Message from Telford and Wrekin Council - Services at Princess Royal Hospital under threat – show your support



Services at the Princess Royal Hospital are under threat of closure and being moved to Shrewsbury. NHS management plan to move the new Women & Children's Centre and A&E services away from PRH. Telford & Wrekin Council believes this makes no sense.

The £28 million Women & Children's Centre was opened only two years ago and was chosen because clinically Telford was the best location. Telford and Wrekin is one of the fastest growing areas in the region and so retaining full A&E services is also vital.
