


Year 1 homework tasks.



Our topic in Year 1 this term is Plants.



All of these activities are linked to our topic. Please try and complete as many of these activities as possible to enhance your child's learning experience.

English Can you create a poster about looking after plants? Think about what plants need to survive and why we enjoy having them!	Art Be Creative! You can either draw/paint plants that you can see or think of other creative ways to put plants into art!	Research Can you find out where different plants grow? Maybe some countries have different plants to us? Think about different climates such as rainforests and deserts!
Science/Maths It would be lovely to see examples of children planting their own plants! To link this with maths you could even measure how tall they grow over the half term... Maybe sunflowers would be a good choice!	Maths Can you practise recognising your numbers? Practise reading and writing numbers as high as possible and completing some addition and subtraction problems.	
Be Creative! Can you think of your own activity to link with Plants? This can be anything you like. I am looking forward to seeing where your learning takes you!		

Rather than having weekly tasks, we would like children to read at home as often as possible (minimum 3 times a week) and for this to be recorded in their reading records. Records and books need to be in school daily and books will be changed **weekly**. Once a child has read their book we ask that you encourage them to re-read the books to build up their fluency and expression to become confident readers. Children are also encouraged to read other appropriate material if they wish and this can also be recorded in the record.
