<p><b>English</b> Can you write about your favourite animals? Try and describe what they look like and what they eat and any other interesting facts!</p>	<p><b>Art</b> Be Creative! Try and make, draw or paint animals in which ever way you like!</p>	<p><b>Research</b> Can you find out where different animals are from? This can link to your English work - Think about what the weather is like too!</p>
<p><b>Science</b> Think about what animals need to survive and how we look after them. Have you got any pets at home you can take photos of and tell us how you look after them?</p>		<p><b>Maths</b> Can you use coins to make these different amounts? 7p 8p 12p 15p 23p 30p 35p 40p 50p 55p</p> <p>Think about whether there is more than one way to make these amounts and see if you can make any of your own!</p>

Rather than having weekly tasks, we would like children to read at home as often as possible (minimum 3 times a week) and for this to be recorded in their reading records. Records and books need to be in school daily and books will be changed **weekly**. Once a child has read their book we ask that you encourage them to re-read the books to build up their fluency and expression to become confident readers. Children are also encouraged to read other appropriate material if they wish and this can also be recorded in the record.
