You also need to learn your 3x and 4x table facts.

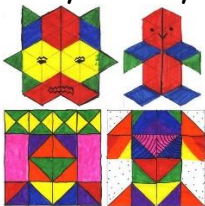
### Homework Activities

You can choose from the activities below to do as part of your homework. You should be spending at least 30 minutes on homework each week, but some tasks will take longer than others.

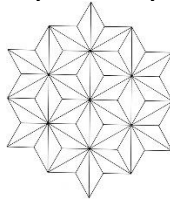
#### **Symmetry 1**

Create your own symmetrical pattern. You can use any materials. It can have 1 or more lines of symmetry.



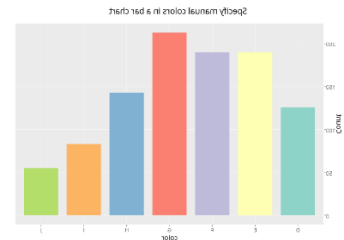
#### **Symmetry 2**

#### **Model Making**

Use a small cardboard box (like a shoe box) to make a model of a kitchen or bathroom where tiles are used. You can use drawing or collage for the tiles.
