### UNIFORM

As you are aware, we have high expectations of uniform at the Academy. Can you please ensure that your child(ren) come to the Academy in the correct uniform. Uniform consists of the following items, which are available for purchase from our supplier Baker and Sons, Wellington:

- Black blazer with logo (Year 6 only)
- Grey jumper/ cardigan with Academy logo
- Academy tie
- Black or charcoal grey trousers/skirts
- White shirt
- Black school shoes (not trainers)
- PE Kit— black short or jogging bottoms, plain white t-shirt and trainers.
- No hooped earrings or large headdress

Uniform at the Academy is compulsory. Therefore if your child/ren are not wearing this there will be a phone call home where you will be required to bring in the correct uniform or collect your child if you are unable to do so.
