ROAD SAFETY

This week we had a visit from a Road Safety Officer from Telford and Wrekin Council to promote how to stay safe near the roads during the darker months.



The best advice for road users is:

- To be mindful of the changing conditions and adjust the way we drive, ride, cycle or walk to ensure it is appropriate for the conditions
- Be safe, be seen – pedestrians, cyclists, and horse-riders should consider wearing fluorescent by day and reflective by night
- Drivers should slow down and pay attention, especially around school buses, when children are likely to be boarding or alighting.
- Outside of the Academy, please adhere to the 20mph speed limit in operation!
