


## Year 4 homework tasks.

<p><b>English</b> Can you create an information poster about our science topic? Think of the scientific language we have used in school. Remember, you can use our science board in class to help think of some of the words.</p>	<p><b>Geography</b> Can you do some research on how water changes to form rain by looking at the water cycle? You can also look at how much rain different places get and maybe draw a diagram of the water cycle.</p>	<p><b>Research</b> Can you find ways to change water at home? Think of using the freezer and heating the water up. Make sure you do this part with an adult! Can you change any other materials in these ways?</p>

I am looking forward to seeing where your learning takes you!</p>		<p><b>Maths</b> Please practise a variety of times tables regularly. Rather than having weekly tasks, we would like children to read at home as often as possible (minimum 3 times a week) and for this to be recorded in their reading records. Records and books need to be in school daily and books will be changed **weekly (children can have own choice books from the library which they can change as often as they like)**. Once a child has read their book we ask that you encourage them to re-read the books to build up their fluency and expression to become confident readers. Children are also encouraged to read other appropriate material if they wish and this can also be recorded in the record.
