HEAD LICE

A reminder to check your child's hair for head lice. As with most schools, from time to time the children's hair may become prone to infection. This can be easily treated with shampoos and lotions from any supermarket or pharmacy.

WASHING HANDS

Can we advise parents and carers to remind children to wash and dry their hands after using the toilet, before eating and when they are dirty. Hands can transfer a number of germs, which can in turn cause children and adults to pick up infections.

We have reminded the children of the importance of washing hands and will continue to do so. Your support with reminding children is as always appreciated.

NAIL BITING

We also try to discourage children from biting their nails, as this can also be a source of unwanted infections and germs.

UNIFORM

We have high expectations of uniform at the Academy. Can you please ensure that your child(ren) come to the Academy in the correct uniform. Uniform consists of the following items, which are available for purchase from our supplier Baker and Sons, Wellington:

- Black blazer with logo (Year 6 only)
- Grey jumper/ cardigan with Academy logo
- Academy tie
- Black or charcoal grey trousers/skirts
- White shirt
- Black school shoes (not trainers)
- PE Kit—black short or jogging bottoms, plain white t-shirt and trainers.
- No hooped earrings or large headdress


