Year 2—Miss Ferris— 95.67%

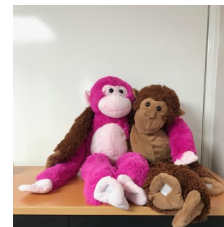
Year 3— Ms Palmer— 98.82% (Arthur's Class for the week!)
