How many children qualify for free school meals?

- % of pupils eligible for free school meals at any time during the past 6 years - 48% of the cohort (12 children)
- 'PPG' based on 12 pupils
- 'All' progress based only on 23 pupils
- 'All' other scores based on 25 pupils

Data Shows:

- PPG pupils made better progress than their peers nationally in all three core subjects;
- In comparison with their peers in the Academy, PPG pupils were in-line with, or their progress was greater than that of their peers (their outcomes were greater in reading);
- Average scores for reading and maths show that PPG did not perform as well as their peers
