This term we are going to travel back in time and visit the Great Fire of London of 1666. Here are some ideas of things you may wish to do at home alongside weekly reading, spellings and x tables. Enjoy ☺

Create a model of 1666 London on fire! Include houses, smoke and flames. You may also include part of the River Thames and The Tower of London in it.

The Great Fire of London started in a bakery on Pudding Lane. Have a go at baking something you could sell in bakery. Take a picture of the final product to show us or bring it in for us to try.



Think about the measurements involved and what price you could charge for your baking. What if you were baking lots, for example 10, how much money could you make?

Samuel Pepys kept a diary of events during The Great Fire of London. Keep your own diary for a weekend and write about all the things you do.

Look around you and find things that are in place to prevent fire spreading e.g. smoke detectors. Design a poster to promote fire safety. Get together as a family and create an escape plan for your home.



Create a timeline about a famous person or all about you. Predict what might happen to you in the future.

Find out about famous people of the past. Thomas Farriner, Samuel Pepys or King Charles II. Draw their portraits or create a fact sheet about them.



Research the Great Fire of Edinburgh in 1824. How was it similar and different to the Great Fire of London 1666? Compare the homes and technology used.

Samuel Pepys famously buried his valuable cheese in his garden to protect it from the fire. Make a list or create a box of what precious things you would save in the event of a fire.
