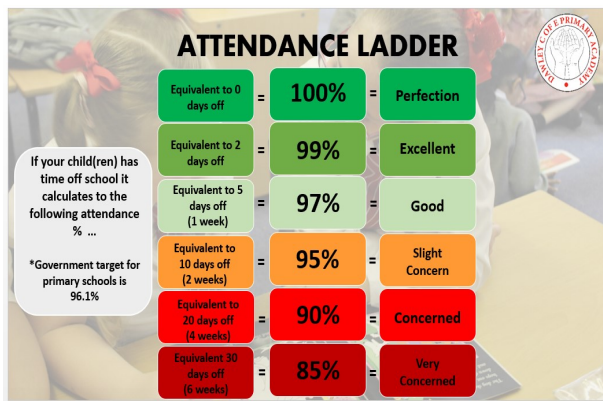

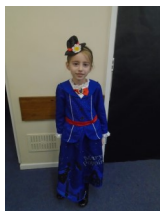
ATTENDANCE
