



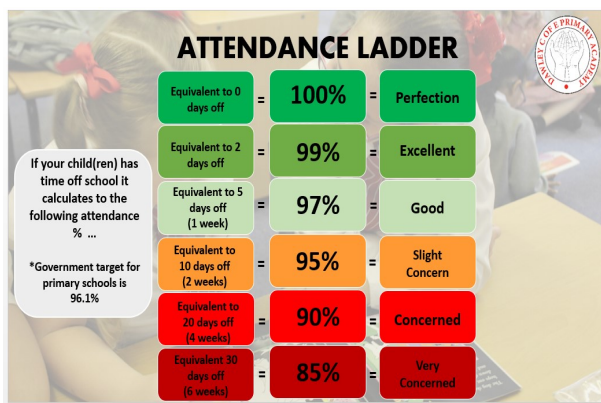

KS1 AND KS2 SATS

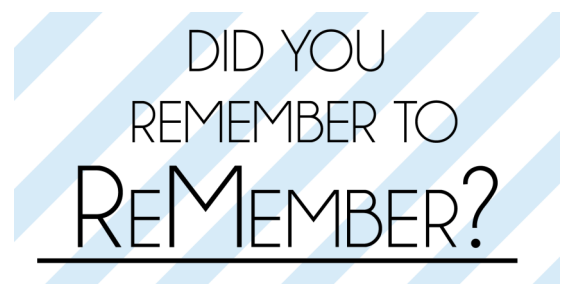
