

## Year 3&4 week 2 French

Resources needed – the table below, the activity sheet on page 2 and colouring pencils.

Bonjour! This week we are going to be learning about food and drink. Yummy! So below is a table of the new words, again there is French, how we say it and English. Allez!

French	How we say it	English
Une pizza	Un pee za	A pizza
Des frites	Day freet	Some chips
Du Poulet	Dew poo lay	Some chicken
Des legumes	Day leg umes	Some vegetables
Du fromage	Dew fram arj (soft j sound)	Some cheese
Un gateau	Un gat o (say the o as you would in the KS2 alphabet)	A cake
Un the	Un tae	A tea
Un coca	Un co ka	A cola
Un café	Un kafay	A coffee
Des bonbons	Day bon bon	Some sweets
Une glace	Un glass	An ice-cream
J'aime	(letter j to be said as if in KS1) j em	I like
J'adore	Ja door	I love
Qu'est-ce que tu aimes manger?	Kes k chew em monjay?	What do you like to eat?

Ok, I want you to learn these words as a group and say them lots of times until you are really clear about how to say them and what they mean.

Once you are feeling really confident about the names of the foods, the responses and the question, I want you to ask and answer the question in turn. So...

Question – Qu'est-ce que tu aimes manger?

Answer – J'adore une pizza

Once the person has answered, can the rest of the group say what the person likes to eat? Go round the group each asking and answering the question.

The next sheet has the names of the food in French and a blank box next to it. Can you draw a picture of the food to match the French word?
