Coronavirus (COVID-19) Symptom Checker

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

It is important to keep on top of personal hygiene, and ensuring that the children are aware to '**Catch it**' in a tissue, '**Bin it**' straight into a bin and '**Kill it**' by washing their hands for 20 seconds.



UNIFORM REMINDER

Can we remind all parents and carers to ensure their children are sent each morning wearing the correct uniform and are looking smart and presentable. Children must also be wearing school shoes, not boots or trainers, and school ties **must** be worn each day.
