Reading Due to Covid 19 we have decided that at present no school reading books will go home. The children will have a reading book in class and will be encouraged to read everyday. It is still expected that your child reads at least 3 times a week at home from a book of their choice. Please message me if you are unable to provide a suitable book at home.

Spellings and Times tables Every Friday children will be given a sheet of times table facts and spellings to learn for a test the following Friday. Please keep this sheet at home and encourage them to learn as many as they can.

Please work based on your child's ability level. It is ok that some children may learn a few whilst others may wish to learn all.

Spring Term 'Explore Europe' and Extreme Earth Topics

Create a fact file about a European country including as much information as possible. Create a quiz about Europe.

Write a postcard from a European destination including what you have seen, activities you have done and food you have eaten. Or make a travel poster to advertise a country in Europe, detailing places of interest and all relevant information you can find.

Find out the heights of different mountains or mountain ranges in Europe. Put them in ascending order. Create some calculations linked to these.

Cook or bake a traditional dish from a European country. Bring it in or take pictures of you making it.

Make your own model of a European landmark. For example The Leaning Tower of Pisa, Big Ben or the Eiffel Tower.

Find out the names of the countries of Europe and their capital cities. List these or draw a map.

Learn a song in a European language, for example Frere Jacques in French.

Create a poster displaying a range of European flags.

What is the weather like in Dawley? Keep a diary of the weather in Dawley over the next term. Make notes on information like: cloudy; sunny; hot; rainy; cold etc.

Can you create your own model of a volcano? Can you get it to erupt?

Research how natural phenomena e.g. earthquakes, hurricanes, hurricanes. Where and Why do they occur? How are they measured? What extreme facts can you find out about Earth? What are the weirdest facts? E.g. Which is the worlds most active volcano? Record breaking tsunamis?
