


ATTENDANCE

Rules on school attendance are clear and state:

- It is a parents' duty to send their child to school regularly if they are of compulsory school age;
- It is schools' responsibility to record attendance and follow up absence
- the local authority is able to resume the use of legal sanctions, including penalty notices and processes that may lead to prosecution in court for persistent absence.

In order to help you child achieve the best possible and sustained education, their attendance needs to be as close to 100% as possible. Government targets are 96.1% but we strive to achieve as close to 100% as possible. Therefore leave during school/term time should not be booked, these will not be granted, unless there are exceptional reasons. All medical appointments should be booked outside school times where possible.



REWARDS

We reward children termly for positive attendance – those with 95%+, 98%+, 99%+ and 100%. This will range from small gifts, toys and vouchers. At the end of each academic year we have a whole school assembly and celebrate the achievements of the children, including those who have made it in everyday or nearly everyday. Prizes have included £5 up to £50 Smyths Toy vouchers; scooters and bikes – which as meant that some families have received more than one or two prizes for their commitment and hard work!

SICKNESS

We ask that you ensure your child attends daily and on time. If your child is ill, but well enough to attend, please send them in, we will keep an eye on them and call you if symptoms do not improve. If your child is off, calls will be made by one of our Attendance Team to discuss this, and offer support where needed. We also have access to the Education Welfare Officer (EWO), Helen Carolina, who will make contact and house calls to those children whose attendance is causing concerns.

As we embark on a new school year, we ask that you work with us to ensure your child receives the best education they are entitled to and this means they should attend daily. Working together we will be able to achieve this.

ATTENDANCE

The overall attendance for Reception class to Year 6 is 91.3%. Well done to **Year 3** last week! At the Academy we strive to be at or above national expectation of 96.1%. We know with your support we can achieve this.
