

Physical Development

- Begin to take part in team games.
- Explore how to use outdoor equipment in wet/icy weather and safety precautions.
- Frozen ice blocks
- PE lessons—follow adult instructions
- Begin to make up games for themselves.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Talk about feelings.
- Develop their sense of responsibility
- Understand their place in the world.
- Begin to use words such as 'happy', 'sad', 'cross' and 'worried'.
- Look at the community around them.
- Look at dressing for the seasons

Communication and Language

- Join in with known songs and stories
- Listen to simple stories.
- Join in with listening games
- Actively take part in circle time.
- Continue to look at turn taking

Writing—

- Use a wide range of mark making implements
- Begin to write the first letter of their name
- Following over the pattern of their initial

- Begin to notice simple patterns.

Characteristics of effective learning

Playing and exploring

- * Showing curiosity with new objects, textures
- * PDR sessions - enabling children to initiate their own play and interests

Active Learning

- * Outdoor provision—learning about new equipment and how to use it safely.

- * Investigate materials by testing ideas, theories and predictions
- * Outdoor provision

Understanding of the World

- Talk about special times within their family.
- Celebrations—Diwali, Bonfire Night, Christmas
- Compare seasons.
- Understanding their body—PANTS session

We will be looking at colour, exploring what happens when we mix colours and textures together.




We will be looking at seasons and how to dress appropriately in these seasons.


